Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>The event “Revival of Relations Between the Twin Communes of Zsadany and Tinca” was implemented as a Town Twinning activity under the CERV programme, jointly organized by the Zsadany Self-Government (Hungary) and the Tinca Town Hall (Romania). The activities took place over three consecutive days, 22-24 August 2025, in Zsadany, Hungary. Organized across several public venues-including the Cultural Center, the Town Hall, the „Attila Fapalota” wooden community building, and the local football field-the event ensured broad access for both direct participants and the general public.</p>			

The project achieved all its proposed goals, serving as an organized platform for citizens of both communes to strengthen their social, cultural, and economic ties.

**Project Objectives:**

- Strengthened the participants' sense of belonging to the European Union.
- Increased knowledge and understanding of European values and the EU's role in local development.
- Reinforced social, economic, and cultural ties between Zsadany and Tinca.
- Encouraged solidarity and mutual understanding through grassroots interaction.
- Provided a diverse and accessible programme for a wide demographic.

The event involved 240 direct participants (120 from Zsadany and 120 from Tinca), aged between 18 and 80 years. For this group, participation was balanced in terms of gender and inclusive of various social groups, including young people, elderly citizens, and members of the Roma community.

Additionally, the project reached more than 3,000 indirect participants from the general public, who attended the open cultural and sports activities. These participants came from the host locality of Zsadany and its surrounding areas, as well as visitors from the twinned municipality of Tinca.

**Implemented Activities:**

- Presentations and interactive debates on civic participation, European values, and local cooperation.
- Round tables involving town halls, schools, NGOs, and cultural leaders.
- Amateur theatre, traditional dances, folk performances, and concerts.
- A cross-border culinary competition and professional archery sessions.
- A football match fostering informal bonds and teamwork.
- The ceremonial planting of the Friendship Tree, representing the lasting bond between the two localities.

Through direct interaction, the direct participants from both municipalities had the opportunity to form lasting friendships and gain a better understanding of the European Union's role in their daily lives. By working and celebrating together, they grew closer, and the joint activities fostered a sense of belonging to a shared European community.

At the same time, for the indirect participants, the event was a celebration of togetherness that brought the community to life through music, sport, and tradition.
